Chamber Orchestra

1. Two to three-minute prepared solo piece from standard repertoire, memorization is not required. Orchestral parts or string method books will not count as solo piece (with the exception of Suzuki method books). Students should discuss with their private teacher on the appropriate level of the piece. For reference, the solo should be at a similar level to Suzuki Book 5+ that demonstrates the technical skills listed below (2).

If the selected piece is longer than three minutes, please play the section that best demonstrate the student's technique and musicality. At the conductors' discretion, students may be asked to play a different section of the piece.

Please provide 2 extra copies of your solo piece for conductors.

- 2. Students are expected to showcase the following technical skills:
 - Standard bow strokes such as staccato, spiccato, legato, slurred bowing, and staccato with slur over
 - Double stops and chords
 - Vibrato
 - Shifting (violin/viola: up to 5th position; cello/bass: up to 7th position with introductory thumb position)
 - Tuning the instrument
- 3. Sight-reading will be provided at the audition.
